



**CONDITIONS**

1. Full barricading affixed with "Road Closed" signs (as designated under the *Qld Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices*) shall be erected on both sides of the closure point with 'Road Closed Ahead' signs erected prior to road closure and amber flashing lights to be utilised during hour of darkness;
2. All police directions shall be complied with at all times;
3. This permit may be cancelled or the conditions altered by a police officer for the safe and effective regulation of traffic, or the safety of the general public and participants;
4. All roads shall be re-opened at the nominated times;
5. All debris and associated material to be removed from roadway prior to re-opening of roadway to road users;
6. The Qld. Fire and Rescue Service, Qld. Ambulance Service and Rocky Cabs shall be advised of the road closures;
7. The applicant shall advertise the street closure in the Morning Bulletin on Saturday 27/05/2017 prior to closure date;
8. The issue of this permit does not exempt the applicant from obtaining any relevant permit or authority required by another authority, occupier or owner, e.g. Local Government, Main Roads Department, private property owner, lease holder, etc.;
9. Workplace Health and Safety requirements to be complied with at all times;
10. This permit is not transferable and shall remain in force unless sooner surrendered, suspended or cancelled;
11. A copy of this permit (and all associated permits) shall be held by the applicant or nominated person and shall be produced to police if required.

*Transport Operations (Road Use Management – Accreditation and Other Provisions)

#### CONDITIONS

1. A person to whom a special event permit is issued must ensure that the conditions of the permit are complied with. Maximum penalty - 20 penalty units;
2. Prior to the commencement of the event, all participants and drivers of event support vehicle/s shall be made aware of the terms and conditions of this permit;
3. The authorised route shall be followed and no deviations made by participants without prior consultation with local police;
4. The event shall only be conducted during the hours of daylight;
5. This permit does not exempt participants and drivers of event support vehicle/s from compliance with the provisions of the *Transport Operations (Road Use Management – Road Rules) Regulation 2009* nor any other legislation (unless expressly stated in this permit);
6. The issue of this permit does not exempt the applicant from obtaining any relevant permit or authority required by another authority, occupier or owner, e.g. Local Government, Department of Transport and Main Roads, private property owner, lease holder, etc.;
7. Participants and drivers of event support vehicle/s shall take all necessary precautions to avoid any road incidents and shall immediately obey any lawful direction given by a police officer;
8. Event support vehicle/s designated by the applicant as safety vehicle/s, shall operate a flashing yellow/amber light affixed to the roof of the event support vehicle;
9. The event shall be temporarily suspended by the applicant, participant/s or police if undue traffic delays are experienced along the route. The suspension shall be for as long as it takes to clear the traffic build-up;
10. The applicant shall ensure that the event is either suspended or cancelled if for any reason there is a danger to participants, other road users or the general public e.g. heavy rain, fog, serious accident, etc.;
11. Where participants are unable to proceed due to adverse or unsafe conditions, or official signs prohibit cyclists, event support vehicle/s shall convey participants to a location;
12. All stoppages along the route shall be conducted in places that are located off the roadway e.g. parks, rest areas, etc.;
13. All Event Marshals are to be identifiable by wearing of either a yellow or orange fluorescent safety vest;

14. The applicant shall ensure that children participating in the event are fully supervised and closely monitored by responsible adults at all times;
15. The applicant shall ensure that any animals involved in the event are under the control of a suitably qualified handler at all times;
16. The applicant shall ensure that an operational mobile telecommunications device is carried in each of the event support vehicle/s;
17. The applicant shall ensure that basic first aid supplies are carried in each of the event support vehicle/s;
18. This permit may be cancelled or the conditions altered by a police officer for the safe and effective regulation of traffic, or the safety of the general public and participants;
19. No fund-raising shall be conducted from the roadway;
20. Suitable public liability insurance should be arranged to cover this event;
21. A copy of this permit (and any associated permits) shall be held by the applicant during the event and shall be produced to police if required.
